Dear Mr. Howard.

Having been intensively busy revising, annotating, improving and reediting my 46 Miniatures, I am therefore late in answering your very kind letter. The new edition will be in six volumes and will be published in about a fortnight. I will send you a complete set, so that you will be able to compare this edition with the old one. By doing so you will notice the subtle changes and the great care I bestowed upon marks of interpretation.

I appreciate fully your heartfelt sympathy for my works and with my lot and I am sincerely grateful for it.

I have nothing new to relate to you about my doings, but there are plans in the air to make me the head of an international music institute, located in California. However, the plan is far from being settled yet. I also am in touch with the Russian Government to teach two months every year in *Moscow*. The plan is to give the lessons on the stage of a big theatre where the students would play, while the audience, consisting of hundreds of teachers, would profit by my criticisms.

Are you making any headway with the propaganda for my Master Classes in Australia and New Zealand ?

Mr. I. Philip , the most known pedagogue in France, has been teaching here the last few months. He is a very devoted friend of mine. He left a few days ago for Paris.
